INTRODUCTION

The **2/Cento** (Due cento or "Two Hundred" in English) is a stereo power amplifier for electric guitar. Featuring 2xKT88/side and a very high voltage internal supply is designed for a nearly infinite headroom.

DIMENSIONS

Measurements: 4U standard rack with a depth of 40cm/ 15,7 inches.

Weight: 38kg / 84lb

POWER SUPPLY

2/cento is shipped with hardwired primary voltage. 230V or 117V must be chosen at order time.

FIRST USAGE

Take your time and carefully check the cabinet impedance before turning the **STANDBY** switch on. The cabinet impedance must match the amplifier's output impedance or be higher.

Do not attempt to change the output jacks (impedance) while the amplifier is on. Always turn both the STANDBY and POWER switches to the OFF position before adjusting the output impedance.

WARNING!!

This amplifier uses potential lethal voltage, it must be inspected only by expert people! Do not open unless being authorized.

WARNING!!

Before insert power cord inside 2/cento, check the voltage plate under IEC socket and be sure to match wall voltage of your country.

2/CENTO

The 2/Cento is a stereo power amplifier designed for electric guitar, featuring a B+voltage close to 680VDC and delivering approximately 90 watts per side through two pairs of KT88 tubes. The result is an exceptionally wide, clean, and transparent sound, with virtually no distortion and almost limitless headroom.

Pair the 2/Cento with your favorite preamplifier — we highly recommend trying our D100PRE — and experience outstanding performance. For additional effects, place them between your preamp and the power amp; our Multi Stereo Line Mixer is also highly recommended to complete your setup. Due to the very high production costs and time consuming manhours to craft every single power amplifier, availability is limited to 10 to 20 pieces a year.

TECHNICAL FEATURES

FRONT PANEL:




Global controls:

- POWER ON/OFF: turn main power on/off;
- STEREO VOLUME: volume control for both sides simultaneously.
- LINK ON: turn the STEREO VOLUME control on. This control defeat channel volume controls and both sides will be controlled by it.

Left and right channels:

- VOLUME: volume control;
- PAD: cut the channel volume roughly by 1/10.
- **VOICE:** select two different feedback path. One it's more open and with high content, the other is smoother and darker.
- PRESENCE: presence control.
- DEPTH: depth or low content control.
- STANDBY: standby switch on/off

REAR PANEL



(from left to right)


- IEC power connector;
- Left and Right input connectors: by using LEFT side only, signal will also sent to RIGHT channel, so both channels can be used. When RIGHT side is plugged in, 2/Centro will work as a regular stereo PA.
- 4-8-16 ohm output connectors.

TUBE LAYOUT

This amplifier comes equipped with KT88 tubes in power amp section and 12AX7 and 12AT7 tubes in the preamp.

Power tubes cannot be replaced with other types. Bias must be checked every time power amp tubes are substituted, even with ones by the same brand.

Adjusting the bias requires an expert tech and the amplifier to be opened, so please contact us at **info@redseven-amplification.com** before attempting this for any information.

V1 and V2: input stages. 12AX7 V3 and V4: phase inverters. 12AT7

V5 to V8: KT88

CABINET AND SPEAKERS

For the ultimate sonic experience, we highly recommend pairing this amplifier with the **RedSeven Pro Cab series**, especially the **4x12 model**. This amplifier was developed specifically with this cabinet, making it a natural extension of its sound.

TROUBLESHOTTING

- 2/Cento IS NOT TURNING ON Check the power cord, sometimes it can be loose and cannot make good contact with IEC socket. Replace it. If this doesn't work check MAIN fuse, if it's blown replace with SAME type and try again to turn on again. If fuse continue to blown, turn off the amp and contact RedSeven Amplification.
- 2/Cento IS TURNING ON BUT WITH NO SOUND
 First of all be sure to connect speaker cable properly, both amplifier as the cabinet.
 Check the input signal from guitar and channel/master volume too. If this doesn't work check HT fuse, if it's blown replace with SAME type and try again to turn on again. If fuse continue to blown, turn off the amp and contact RedSeven Amplification.
- 2/Cento IS MAKE NO SOUND

 If everything works properly be sure to have both master volume turned up.
